About the CO₂ Dragster Contest:

The objective of this contest is to teach students of whatever age about the importance of materials, their properties, and their selection, through the design and construction of a small, CO_2 jet powered dragster.

These vehicles are similar to the well-known Technology Student Association (TSA) CO_2 cars propelled along a straight, level track by a conventional CO_2 cartridge as used in BB guns. The materials challenge is to allow other materials of construction to reduce the weight of the vehicle to decrease the run time, but still maintain the strength required to survive two runs down the track. The participants are encouraged to think about the materials they use, and must write a one page summary of these considerations as a part of their official entries.

Cash prizes will be awarded in the Middle School and High School Divisions. Time permitting, there will also be a Senior or Open Division in which anyone may participate, so bring your ideas and let's see how fast we can make these things.
